Note: If your child is new to Magdalen Farm Strings please could you let us have a brief written or emailed assessment from his or her instrumental teacher or Head of Music. This helps us to group players in advance according to ability and plan the timetable accordingly, thus saving time and ensuring that your child gets full benefit right from the start. The report can be enclosed with your application: if this not possible, please arrange to get it to us at the earliest opportunity. Advance groupings are not set in stone: it soon becomes clear if a player is not in the right group.

Magdalen Farm Strings T-shirt (sizes S, M, L or XL)

The T-shirt is 100% cotton, white or black with Magdalen Farm Strings logo on the front. It is worn at the concert and for photo sessions (but is *not* compulsory). Returning musicians can bring their old ones with them. New T-shirts are not sent out in advance: they are handed out at Magdalen Farm. Cost £10.

End-of-course buffet lunch After the concert at Magdalen Farm for families and sponsors on the morning of the last day, a buffet lunch will be available. Cost £10 a head, for participants and relatives, *younger* siblings free. We will ask for bookings and payment for the lunch when details of things to bring, medical form, etc are sent out nearer the time.

(£10 reduction per child applies for fees paid in full before 31 January 2019. £10 per applicant can also be deducted for siblings)

Deposit of £100 (£50 day) secures a place. Please note that once Magdalen Farm Strings has confirmed and accepted your registration, cancellation after 3 March 2019 will be charged *in full*, unless accompanied by an official medical certificate.

Participants are encouraged to raise their course fees through sponsored activities. A draft sponsorship form and letter are available, easily adaptable to personal circumstances (let us know if you would like copies of these). We work hard to keep fees as low as possible but realise that it is difficult for some people: putting away a small amount each month can help to lessen the blow. Part-bursaries may be available for cases of genuine hardship.
